

- Centre Rally Officers Guidance Notes This was hoped to be in place for the Blue Nose Rally, however that may slip due to time constraints. This should not have a detrimental impact to any Rallies held before this guidance is revised, but the Rally Secretary can be contacted for points of clarification.

Current workstreams for the website include:

- Uploading new photos to the Photo Gallery As users of the website will have noticed, the photo gallery has not been updated since 2018. There are many reasons for this, however a large number of photos have recently been sent in, thanks to Wendy Goddard, covering Rallies from the 50th Celebration and beyond. There has been a delay in uploading these due to the mechanics of the website administration and the time taken, however the process has also raised the question of 'permissions' and 'use of photographs'.
- The guidance to Centres from the CAMC is as follows: "Photography/videography may be taken at our Centre events and rallies. The Centre and Club may use any photograph(s) and/or video(s) they take that include you, your party and/or outfit in all and any media, including printed and electronic publications, eg websites, or promotional materials, in the advertising of its goods or services. The photograph(s) and/or video(s) may be stored for these purposes as well. If you do not want to appear in any shots, please advise the organiser if it relates to a specific event, or the Centre Secretary if for all events. They will do their best to accommodate this and ensure you can avoid the area being photographed/filmed."
 - We have adapted this wording to suit our Centre and it will be displayed on the website, on Rally information and included in newsletter such as this. Whilst there is no need for a Centre to collect written consent, we will maintain a list of Members that wish to opt out of having photographs used. Please email webmaster@berkshirecentrecaravanclub.co.uk with your details to be included on this list.
- History of the Berkshire Centre There is a lack of historical information currently on the
 website. It is hoped that by working with Members we can include a history page on the website
 detailing the formation of the Berkshire Centre, Past Chairman roll of honour, key moments
 in history, and key events.
- New Members Letter / Email This process is out of date and has not recovered from the COVID lockdown time. The Committee are looking to update the format and process to welcome New Centre Members properly.

Pets on Rallies

In response to question from Ralliers recently, the Committee would like to reiterate that pets are welcome on all rallies. All pets must be kept on a lead and under full control of a responsible person at all times during a rally. Pets are to be exercised well away from caravans (or off-site on school sites) and any fouling from pets must be cleared up from the rally site immediately.

Pets are not allowed at socials held in enclosed buildings, gazebos or marquees.
